

REGIONAL DELEGATE REPORT: Christine B.S.

- **SCRNA Procedure for Submitting CAR Motions:**

- 1. All proposed CAR motions, regardless of origin, will be considered.
 - The SoCal Region's groups, a minimum of twelve weeks prior to the submission deadline
 - The SoCal Region's Areas, a minimum of eight weeks prior to the submission deadline
 - The SoCal Region at the RSC, a minimum of four weeks prior to the submission deadline
- 2. SCRNA CAR motions can originate from a group, an ASC, the RSC or the RD team but must be considered in the order described in #1.
- Virtual WSLD 2020 was held November 20 & 21
- Financial status: Questions sent by a member:
 - If NAWS has accepted a PPP loan, why are there still furloughed employees?
 - What method was used in determining which employees were furloughed?
 - If the PPP funds went into a general fund, how did this meet the intent of the PPP?

Answer: Staff were furloughed because of the drastic and abrupt downturn in revenue. As Anthony reported in April, "on March 18th, we laid off our three newest employees in Chatsworth and reduced all branch operations to 20 hours per week." Two days later, California issued the stay-at-home orders, and those plans changed. On April 3rd, we furloughed 22 staff in Chatsworth and kept 19 staff at 20 hours per week. Half of these remaining staff are working in production, shipping, accounting, and technology. The other half has been answering letters and emails, supporting the WB, preparing reports and working on the virtual WSC. Since that time, all remaining 19 staff are back to full time. The PPP loan did not change anything about operations at NA World Services, it simply provided additional resources to draw on.

The Intent of the Payroll Protection Program or PPP, as stated by the US Small Business Administration, is to provide small business employers with an incentive to keep employees on their payroll.
